## Intentional Transitional Ministry (ITM) Training Qualifications for Applicants

The Division for Ministry of the NACCC is seeking clergy who wish to pursue certification as Intentional Transitional Ministers through the Alban Institute or another DFM approved training program. DFM approves candidates for training based on the following criteria. Candidates must:

- have an appreciation, understanding, and commitment to Congregational Polity and the Congregational Way.
- provide DFM with a signed agreement to serve at least three ITM positions in the NACCC.
- have served or been active in NACCC churches for a minimum of five years.
- have served a church in recognizable conflict.
- have signed a background check release form.
- be willing to sign a covenant indicating his/her intent **NOT** to pursue candidacy for the settled minister's position.
- upon completion of training, register a Minister Disclosure File with the NACCC in accordance with the NACCC Disclosure Protocol and Policy.
