PREFACE

This Worshipbook is prepared for use in the Sunday and Special Services of the Churches. It is intended to encourage simplicity, orderliness, beauty and variety in Christian Services of Worship.

There are two chief formats for Services of public worship. One type is the festal Service which strikes a single note and holds it throughout from trumpet call to benediction. Such are the Services of Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter. The second type follows the universal pattern of 'mood progression' of which the first verses of Isaiah Six are a well known example. Such Services progress from a sense of awe in God's presence to adoration in music, to a prayer for forgiveness, to the hearing of God's Word in Scripture, to praise for the Word, to proclamation of the Word, and Prayer of Dedication, to the Hymn of Resolve, and then to the Benediction and Choral Response. A Service which follows the time-honored path of 'mood progression' may serve many and varied human needs by the several parts of the Service.

Herein there are alternate Orders of Worship, and an ample selection of aids to worship, such as Calls to Worship, Invocations, Calls to Giving, Prayers of Dedication, and Benedictions. Of great importance is 'The Hartford Lectionary,' a five-year calendar of readings for all Sundays, which insures the reading of all the connected passages of the New Testament and much of the Old Testament, and the Psalms.

The Sacraments and Holy Rites are provided with alternate forms, including carefully selected 'watchwords' for new members and a Service of Engagement.

The Christian Year is represented by Services for the Seasons. There is special care given to festal days and to the Great Week. This section is a book in itself.

A Compendium of Commemoration recognizes the need for a wide spectrum of alternate readings, from the New Testament, from the intertestamental books, from the Old Testament, and from the writings of poets and sages.

Prayers for all Seasons suggests ways of approach to God in public worship which touch the common needs of persons in language which is at once contemporary and enduring.

In the experience of every Church there are occasions which occur infrequently. Orders of Service are suggested for each epic day, such as Ground Breaking, Dedication of Deacons, Teachers, Officers, Musicians or a Christian Home.

The Music Section by Professor Ronald Huntington provides an interpretation of the vital role of music in Congregational worship. A wide selection of resources is organized by seasons and by the character of the music. Thus, there are hundreds of suggestions for preludes, postludes, offertories, anthems, solos, oratorios/cantatas, weddings and memorial services. The aim is to provide a varied diet of music which will nurture soul growth.

Congregational Usage includes both polity and procedures. These encompass a Church's Covenant Service; the call of a minister by a Church, licensing and ordaining procedures and services; installation, commissioning, and the preparations therefor. Finally, there is a brief section on what to do in time of trouble, including a "mutual council."

It has been found helpful to place copies of this Worshipbook in the pews alongside the Hymnal, thereby the repetitively duplicated Order of Morning Worship may be replaced. Ample opportunity for a wide variety of expression in worship is provided and individual creativity is encouraged.

The author/compiler bears testimony to the rich blessing of Congregational worship. It lightens dark days, makes glorious hours of sweet communion, and is an earthly fore-taste of fellowship divine.
